Rami Ganor is a special emissary from Keren Kayemeth LeIsrael to Jewish National Fund on the west coast. He mainly focuses his efforts on the current water crisis as well as to build a human infrastructure to carry the organization into the future. For the past five years, Ganor has been an active member of the Israel Council for Security and Peace, which consists of experts and strategists from academia, the foreign ministry, the military and security organizations.

Rami had served in the Israeli Defense Forces from 1960 to 1982 as a paratrooper and later as an officer. His last position was as the head of long-range strategic planning in the military.

He served as JNF regional director of Canada's Midwest region. He served as the first emissary from JNF/ KKL to Australia and later as Director, and he was situated in Sydney. During this time, a very important memorandum of understanding was signed between the US and Australia through JNF on environmental issues.

Born in Haifa, Rami Gnor attended Haifa High School in his youth. In 1972, Ganor graduated the Senior Commander School of the IDF. By 1982, Ganor graduated Tel Aviv University where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree with honors in History and Geography. And in 1987, he added another degree from the Technion, in hotel management.

Ganor is married to his best friend and companion, Noga. Together, they have four children and four grandchildren. Noga is also a retired major in the IDF where she served admirably for 17 years.
