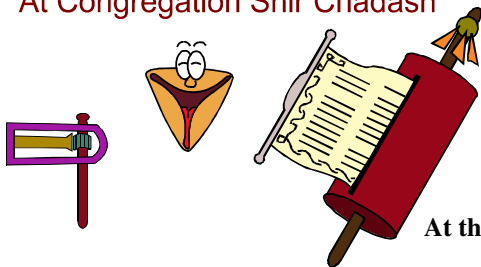

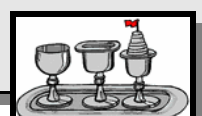

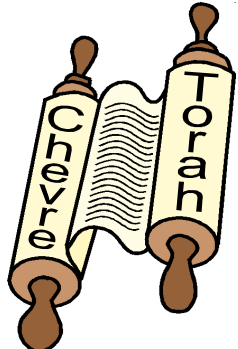
Volunteers Needed

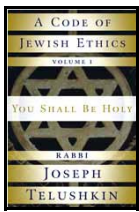
Alone for the 1st night Passover Seder, with
