

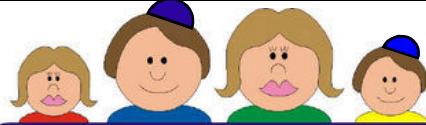

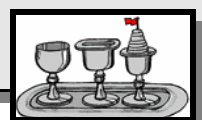

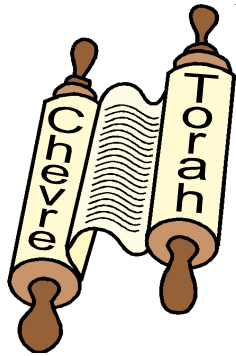
- **Friday, Feb. 9th, Erev Shabbat Service: 7:30 PM**

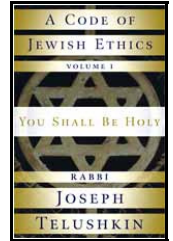


### CHEVRE TORAH
