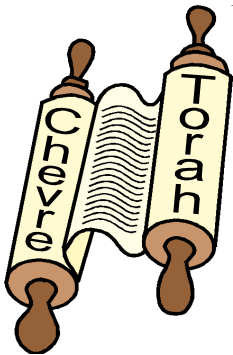

CHEVRE TORAH

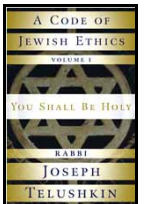
Shabbat mornings, at
