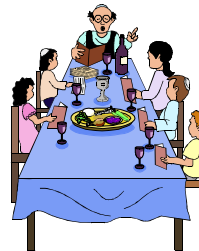

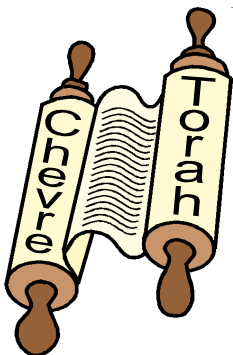

If you can seat one or more people at your 1st night Seder, please let us know.



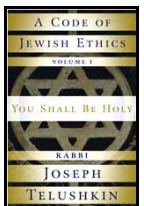
#### CHEVRE TORAH
