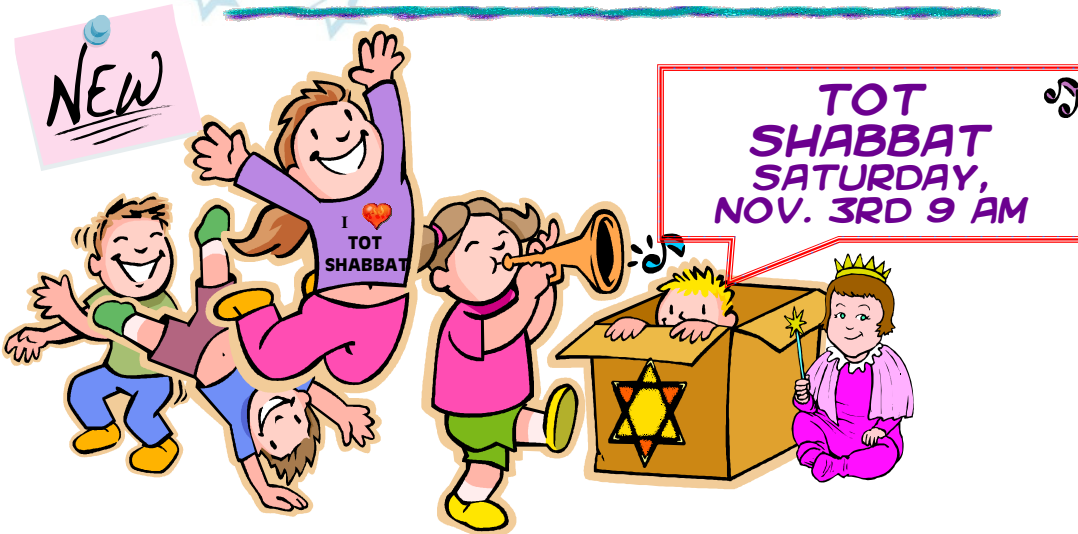
Service Times

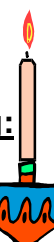
